

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO CENTER SPREAD OF MATERIAL:

 RIGHT-HAND AND LEFT-HAND REFERENCE IS DETERMINED BY STANDING AT THE REAR OF THE BROADCASTER AND FACING THE DIRECTION OF TRAVEL OF TRACTOR.

2. THE MODEL 2440 HAS A CIRCULAR PLATE BOLTED TO BASE OF HOPPER THAT IS ADJUSTABLE, FOR CENTERING THE SPREAD. THIS PLATE IS NUMBERED FROM 1 TO 9 AND THE NUMBERS ARE FOUND ON THE BACK SIDE, ON OPPOSITE SIDE FROM SEED OPENING GAUGE. TO MOVE THE ADJUSTABLE PLATE, LOOSEN 4 CAPSCREWS. ALWAYS BE SURE TO TIGHTEN AFTER ADJUSTING. THE NORMAL SETTING FOR FERTILIZER IS ON 3-1/2, AND MAY BE MOVED TO A HIGHER OR LOWER NUMBER, DEPENDING UPON THE WEIGHT AND QUALITY OF FERTILIZER BEING SPREAD.



3. WHEN SPREAD IS HEAVY ON THE RIGHT SIDE, MOVE BASE PLATE RIGHT, OR CLOCKWISE, TO A HIGHER NUMBER. DO NOT MOVE OVER ONE NUMBER BEFORE CHECKING.

4. WHEN SPREAD IS HEAVY ON THE LEFT SIDE, MOVE BASE PLATE LEFT, OR COUNTER-CLOCKWISE, TO A LOWER NUMBER. DO NOT MOVE OVER ONE NUMBER BEFORE CHECKING.

5. BE SURE THE 4 CAPSCREWS ARE TIGHTENED EVENLY AFTER ADJUSTING.

6. IN EXTREME CONDITIONS TO CENTER THE SPREAD OF MATERIAL, THE BLADES ON FAN MAY BE MOVED FORWARD TO CARRY MATERIAL MORE TO THE <u>LEFT SIDE</u>. ALWAYS MOVE ALL BLADES THE SAME AMOUNT TO ASSURE EVEN SPREADING, WHEN THE BLADES ARE MOVED BACK, THIS ALLOWS THE MATERIAL TO BE SPREAD MORE TO THE RIGHT SIDE. ALWAYS MOVE THE BLADES THE SAME AMOUNT TO ASSURE EVEN SPREADING.

7. THE APPROXIMATE SETTING FOR RYE AND LIKE MATERIALS IS 3-3/4 AND THIS MAY BE VARIED SLIGHTLY TO COMPENSATE FOR THE VARIOUS WEIGHTS AND SIZES OF SEEDS. THE MODEL 2440 MAY BE USED FOR BROADCASTING CLOVERS, ALFALFA, RICE AND OTHER SEEDS, AS WELL AS FERTILIZER. SEE SEEDING INSTRUCTION CHART ON FOLLOWING PAGE AND ALSO ON HOPPER. A FERTILIZER INSTRUCTION CHART IS ALSO ON THE HOPPER. (THE FERTILIZER CHART IS FIGURED AT THE RATE OF 1 CU. FT. FERTILIZER WEIGHING 60 LBS.)

8. BENT FAN BLADES WILL CAUSE POOR SPREADING, REPLACE WHEN BENT, THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE FAN AND BASE SHOULD NEVER BE FARTHER THAN 2-10/32" OR CLOSER THAN 2-5/32", OR IT WILL AFFECT THE SPREAD, REPLACE IN POSITION AS SHIPPED

FROM FACTORY.

 IF MATERIAL HAS A TENDENCY TO PACK, IT IS BEST TO FILL HOPPER IN THE FIELD. IF YOU DO HAVE TO TRAVEL A LONGER DISTANCE, CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN WHEN STARTING FAN AND AGITATOR SO THAT YOU DO NOT SHEAR OFF BOLT IN AGITATOR OR SPRING PIN IN P.T.O.

A SPECIAL TRAILER NO. 269 IS AVAILABLE TO USERS WISHING TO MOUNT THE 2440 ON A TRAILER WHILE USING THE 225

3. FOR HIGHWAY, ORCHARD AND OTHER USERS THAT WISH TO CONTROL SPREAD TO ONE SIDE (EITHER RIGHT OR LEFT), WITH PATTERN ON ONE SIDE, PART NO. 838, SIDE-PATTERN CONTROL KIT MAY BE ORDERED. INSTRUCTIONS ARE INCLUDED IN KIT.

MODEL 2440 BROADCASTER:

SERVICING AND PREPARING MODEL 2440 FOR USE:

- 1. GEARBOX IS SHIPPED FROM THE FACTORY WITH ONE PINT OF NO. 90 MULTIGEAR LUBRICANT. BEFORE USING, CHECK FOR PROPER LUBRICANT LEVEL. REMOVE PLUG AND FILL TO PLUG LEVEL IF LOW.
- 2. CUT THE WIRES HOLDING THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT TO THE BROADCASTER IN SHIPMENT. THEN PLACE THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT ON THE GEARBOX SHAFT AND SECURE IT WITH THE SPRING PIN PROVIDED. FOR AN EXTRA PRECAUTION, YOU CAN RUN A WIRE THROUGH THE SPRING PIN AFTER IT IS INSTALLED AND SECURE IT AROUND THE HUB OF THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT.
- 3. UNWIRE THE UPPER END OF THE PUSH-PULL CABLE NO. 1148 WHICH IS WIRED TO THE BROADCASTER FOR SHIPPING, THEN REMOVE THE CLEVIS AND ONE 3/4" JAM NUT AND WASHER FROM THE END OF THE CABLE. NOW INSERT THE END OF THE CABLE INTO THE HOLE IN THE BRACKET BELOW THE OPENING CONTROL ARM. REINSTALL THE WASHER, JAM NUT AND CLEVIS AND MOVE THE OPENING CONTROL ARM TO THE "0" SETTING ON THE NUMBER SCALE DECAL.
- 4. ADJUST THE CLEVIS ON THE CABLE SO THAT THE PINHOLE AND CLEVIS HOLE ALIGN AND THAT THE OPENING PLATE (PART NO. 1024) INSIDE THE HOPPER IS JUST CLOSED. THE CLEVIS CAN BE SCREWED IN OR OUT TO ACCOMPLISH THIS SETTING. MOVE OPENING CONTROL ARM BY HAND TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL PARTS MOVE FREELY. INSTALL PULL SPRING NO. 1124 BY HOOKING THE LONG OPEN END THAT IS FASTENED TO THE OPENING PLATE, COIL END IN THE HOLE PROVIDED NEXT TO THE CABLE. THIS SPRING WILL REMOVE END-PLAY IN THE CABLE. NOW INSTALL A HYDRAULIC CYLINDER WITH AN 8" STROKE AND OPEN AND CLOSE CYLINDER SHAFT TO CHECK FOR FREE MOVEMENT, MAKING SURE THAT THE NO. 1024 OPENING PLATE DOES NOT OVER CLOSE, OR CABLE DAMAGE WILL RESULT.
- 5. EXTEND CYLINDER SHAFT FULLY AND CHECK THAT OPENING PLATE BARELY CLOSES. IF IT DOES NOT, READJUST AT THE CLEVIS.
- 6. DEPTH-BLOCKS CAN BE USED ON THE CYLINDER SHAFT FOR DESIRED OPENING. 4" OF SHAFT MOVEMENT EQUALS 1" OF OPENING PLATE MOVEMENT AND WILL SHOW EQUAL AMOUNT ON GAUGE SETTING CHART; OR 2" OF SHAFT MOVEMENT EQUALS 1/2" OF OPENING PLATE MOVEMENT; OR 1" OF SHAFT MOVEMENT EQUALS 1/4" OF OPENING PLATE MOVEMENT.
- 7. NEVER LOWER THE SEEDER SO THAT THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT WILL COME APART.
- 8. WHEN RAISING THE SEEDER FOR THE FIRST TIME, MAKE SURE THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT DOES NOT BOTTOM OUT. IF IT DOES, CUT OFF EQUAL AMOUNTS FROM BOTH HALVES OF THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT.
- 9. IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO ADD FRONT END WEIGHTS ON A FEW TRACTORS THAT ARE NOT SUFFICIENTLY HEAVY IN FRONT TO HANDLE THE WEIGHT OF THE SEEDER WHEN FILLED.
- THE SEEDER IS NOW READY TO MOUNT ON A TRACTOR WITH A 3-POINT HITCH OR WITH A FAST-HITCH (QUICK-ATTACHING COUPLER.)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MOUNTING ON A TRACTOR WITH 3-POINT HITCH:

- THE LIFT-ARMS SHOULD BE SET FOR NO. 2 CATEGORY, OR 32-3/8" SPACING SWAY BARS, BLOCKS OR CHAINS MUST BE USED TO KEEP THE SEEDER FROM SWINGING SIDEWAYS.
- 2. REMOVE OR MOVE DRAWBAR TO SIDE POSITION SO AS NOT TO INTERFERE WITH THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT.
- 3. INSTALL SEEDER ON THE TWO LOWER LIFT ARMS FIRST, THEN ATTACH THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT TO THE TRACTOR'S P.T.O.
 "CAUTION"I NOW MAKE SURE THAT THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT IS NOT TO LONG. IF THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT IS TO LONG IT
 WILL BOTTOM OUT AND CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE GEARBOX AND RELATED PARTS AND WILL NOT BE COVERED BY WARRANTY. IF THE
 POWER TAKE-OF SHAFT IS TO LONG YOU WILL NEED TO CUT OFF THE EXCESSIVE LENGTH BEING SURE TO CUT EQUAL AMOUNTS
 OFF OF EACH HALF.
- 4. CONNECT THE CENTER LINK ARM FROM THE TRACTOR TO THE SEEDER AND ADJUST IT SO THE FAN IS LEVEL OR THE TOP OF THE SEEDER IS SLIGHTLY TILTED TOWARD THE TRACTOR WITH THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT BEING LEVEL FROM THE TRACTOR TO THE SEEDER
- 5. IF YOU WISH TO RAISE THE SEEDER HIGHER FROM THE GROUND THAN HAVING THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT LEVEL OR STRAIGHT, DO NOT RAISE THE SEEDER ANY HIGHER THAN WOULD REQUIRE THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT TO RUN AT A 15 DEGREE ANGLE. POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT AND GEARBOX SHAFT SHOULD RUN IN THE SAME PLANE.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MOUNTING SEEDER ON TRACTOR WITH FAST-HITCH: (QUICK-ATTACHING COUPLER)

- INSTALL FAST-HITCH ON TRACTOR.
- BUSHINGS SHOULD BE REPLACED ON LOWER AND UPPER MOUNTING PINS IF THEY HAVE BEEN REMOVED, OR IF NEEDED FOR FAST-HITCH.
- 3. BACK TRACTOR WITH FAST-HITCH UNDER 2440. RAISE FAST-HITCH SLOWLY SO THAT IT WILL LOCK INTO ALL POINTS.
- 4. INSTALL POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT.
- 5. 'CAUTION''! WHEN RAISING THE SEEDER FOR THE FIRST TIME, MAKE SURE THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT DOES NOT BOTTOM OUT. IF IT DOES BOTTOM OUT IT WILL CAUSE THE GEARBOX AND OTHER PARTS DAMAGE. WHEN THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT IS TO LONG YOU MUST CUT EQUAL LENGTHS OFF OF BOTH HALVES.
- RAISE THE SEEDER UP SO THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT RUNS FAIRLY STRAIGHT OR LEVEL. FOR BEST RESULTS, THE CENTER LINK SHOULD BE SHORTENED UNTIL THE SEEDER TILTS A LITTLE FORWARD TOWARD THE TRACTOR.
- 7. IF YOU NEED TO RAISE THE SEEDER HIGHER FROM THE GROUND THAN ALLOWING THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT TO RUN LEVEL, DO NOT RAISE THE SEEDER ANY HIGHER THAN WOULD REQUIRE THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT TO RUN AT A 15 DEGREE ANGLE.

FOR SPREADING DOLOMITE OR DEHYDRATED LIME:

- DO NOT ATTEMPT TO SPREAD DOLOMITE OR DEHYDRATED LIME WITHOUT THE SPECIAL AGITATOR, PART NO. 158.
- INSTALL SPECIAL LIME AGITATOR IN PLACE OF REGULAR AGITATOR.
- WIDTH OF SPREAD WILL BE ABOUT 14 FEET.
- UNDER NORMAL CONDITIONS, 1200 LBS. OF DOLOMITE OR DEHYDRATED LIME WILL GO THROUGH A 1" OPENING WIDTH IN 6 MINUTES. 4.
- FILL HOPPER IN FIELD ONLY...DO NOT DRIVE ANY EXTRA OR UNNECESSARY DISTANCE OR THE MATERIAL WILL PACK. (THE EXTRA DRIVING WILL CAUSE THE AIR TO LEAVE THE DOLOMITE, WHICH IN TURN, ALLOWS THE MATERIAL TO SETTLE AND PACK.)
- DO NOT LEAVE ANY MATERIAL IN HOPPER OVER NIGHT OR ANY EXTENDED TIME, AS THE MATERIAL WILL SETTLE AND PACK. 6.
- RUN TRACTOR PTO NORMALLY AT 540 R.P.M. UNDER SOME CONDITIONS, THE PTO MAY BE RUN SLOWER TO KEEP THE DUST DOWN AND STILL NOT AFFECT THE WIDTH OF SPREAD. DO NOT RUN PTO UNDER 300 R.P.M., HOWEVER.
- DO NOT USE LIME AGITATOR FOR SPREADING REGULAR FERTILIZER. BE SURE AND REPLACE LIME AGITATOR WITH REGULAR AGITATOR FOR SPREADING FERTILIZER AND BROADCASTING SEEDS.

MAINTENANCE:

- BEFORE STORING THE MODEL 2440, IT SHOULD BE WASHED OUT THOROUGHLY WITH WATER, MAKING SURE ALL FERTILIZER HAS BEEN REMOVED. FOR COMPLETE CLEANING, LOOSEN 4 CAP SCREWS THAT HOLD BASE PLATE TO BOTTOM OF HOPPER, SO THERE IS SUFFICIENT ROOM TO WASH OUT ALL CORROSIVE MATERIAL. WHEN DRY, OIL THOROUGHLY, RETIGHTEN PLATE BEFORE USING.
- SEPARATE THE POWER TAKE-OFF SHAFT HALVES AND THOROUGHLY OIL TUBING TO PREVENT "SEIZING" DURING STORAGE.

- TROUBLE SHOOTING TIPS:

 1. IF SPREAD IS NOT WIDE ENOUGH, CHECK FOR SHEARED PINS.
- 2. OTHER CAUSES OF POOR SPREAD:
 - A. BENT FAN BLADES.
 - B. FAN BLADES MOVED FROM FACTORY SETTING, (BLADES SHOULD BE IN LINE WITH LONG MARKS ON FAN.)
 - C. THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE FAN AND BASE SHOULD NEVER BE FARTHER THAN 2-10/32" OR CLOSER THAN 2-5/32", OR IT WILL AFFECT THE SPREAD.
 - D. DO NOT RUN PTO OVER 560 R.P.M. TOO MUCH SPEED CAUSES UNEVEN SPREADS.
 - E. PTO SPEED UNDER 530 R.P.M. WILL RESULT IN A NARROW SPREAD.
- THE MODEL 2440 BROADCASTER SHOULD RUN LEVEL OR TILT FORWARD SLIGHTLY. ALSO, MAKE SURE ONE SIDE IS NOT LOWER THAN THE OTHER. IF IT IS, ADJUST SEEDER SO BOTH SIDES ARE EVEN.
- IF SPREAD IS TOO MUCH ON RIGHT SIDE, MOVE PLATE TO A HIGHER NUMBER AND IF SPREAD IS TOO MUCH ON LEFT SIDE, MOVE PLATE TO A LOWER NUMBER.
- WHEN SEEDER DOES NOT FEED EVENLY:
 - A. CHECK MATERIAL TO SEE IF ANY FOREIGN MATTER IS IN IT.
 - B. CHECK TO SEE THAT AGITATOR IS BEND DOWN CLOSE TO BASE PLATE BUT DO NOT LET IT STRIKE BASE PLATE WHEN IT ROTATES.
 - C. OPENING MAY BE SET TOO CLOSE FOR THE MATERIAL YOU ARE SPREADING. TO OVERCOME THIS, SET THE OPENING LARGER AND DRIVE FASTER.
 - D. RUNNING AGITATOR WHEN NOT SPREADING WILL RESULT IN MATERIAL BEING GROUND UP AND PACKING OVER OPENING. YOU CAN "OVER-AGITATE" MATERIAL.

ADDITIONAL TIPS:
1. FOR TRACTORS WITH 1,000 R.P.M.:

THE GEAR BOX IS DESIGNED SO THAT THE GEARS IN THE GEAR BOX MAY BE REVERSED FOR PROPER FAN SPEED. HOWEVER, IT REQUIRES COMPLETE DISASSEMBLY OF GEARBOX. CALL THE FACTORY FOR INFORMATION ON CONVERTING TO 1,000 R.P.M. AT 219-753-6311
